GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to CLIFDEN, GALWAY

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin**, at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 8.10am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Explore the historic ruins of 15th century **Ross Errilly Friary** or the picturesque village of Cong, filming location for John Wayne's The Quiet Man.

What's the classic postcard image of Ireland? We think you'll find it amid the savage beauty of <u>Connemara</u>. Today is your chance to experience this amazing region.

The setting could not be more scenic for a **farm tour** and **sheepdog demo** at Tom Nee's farm above **Killary Harbour** (Fee Included). Don't worry if we don't get time today; you will enjoy a sheep farm tour on Day 3 instead.

There's a quick photo stop at <u>Kylemore Abbey</u> – one of Ireland's most romantic historic buildings.

Castle Tour & The Burren



CLIFDEN, GALWAY to LAHINCH, CLARE

Take a guided tour of 16th century Aughnanure Castle, ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may occur on Day 3.

We're aiming for buzzy and bohemian Galway city next.

Spot red-sailed traditional boats and picturesque <u>Dunguaire Castle</u> on the shores of Galway Bay.

Next is the bewitching beauty of the **Burren National Park**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora.

Hold onto your hat! It's the 700ft high Cliffs of Moher (Fee Included).

LAHINCH, CLARE to DINGLE, KERRY

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** and **guided farm tour** (Fee Included). This experience may occur on Day 1 on some departures.

Refresh yourself with an ice cold pint at the **South Pole Inn**. Relive the extraordinary deeds of its one time landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

<u>Dingle</u> awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

Today is yours to design. Soak up the charms of <u>Dingle</u>, with quality downtime or a choice between the following relaxed activities.

- A. Take a **boat trip** around spectacular Dingle Bay.
- **B.** Savour a guided **craft tour** of the Dingle Crystal studio.
- **C.** Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity.

Experience <u>Slea Head</u>, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Whatever you do in **Dingle**, don't miss an Irish traditional music session or a stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries and craft studios.

DINGLE, KERRY to GOUGANE BARRA or BANTRY, CORK

Start the day with a scenic drive along the coast of the **Dingle Peninsula**, with a photo stop and a stroll along the beach at Inch
Strand.

Take a **horse-drawn carriage ride** around <u>Killarney National</u> <u>Park</u> (Optional Extras).

Your visit to Killarney National Park may also include:

- Sightings of rare red deer herds in native oak forest
- 19th century Muckross House and Gardens
- A short walk to scenic Torc Waterfall
- Idyllic lakeside and mountain views

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around **ancient stone circles**. Astrology? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

Take a spin over either the **Caha** or **Healy Pass**, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the **Beara Peninsula**.

Bantry House & Boat Trip



GOUGANE BARRA or BANTRY, CORK to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we explore the remote Beara Peninsula.

Of the four peninsulas in Ireland's southwest, the Beara receives the least amount of visitors and has the feeling of true wilderness.

Look out for seals on a scenic **boat trip** to <u>Garnish Island</u>. Once landed, explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Optional Extras). Garnish Island opens from April to October. Departures in March can instead choose a **guided harbour tour** by boat (Optional Extras).

Visit stately **Bantry House**, a grand Irish home built in the 18th century (Fee Included). Please note, Bantry House opens from April to October.

Alternatively, learn about the epic last stand of a Gaelic chieftain at 16th centiury **Carriganass Castle**.

GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — *slán* in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

We'll trace the valley of the **River Lee**, crossing stone bridges and passing through picturesque countryside.

Then it's time to kiss the Blarney Stone (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle.**

En route back to Dublin, enjoy a self-guided tour of the Rock of Cashel (Fee Included). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. It's an epic way to conclude our Irish odyssey.

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new travel buddies!
